The Book of Abstracts will be available on the IEEE-Xplore. For this purpose the IEEE PDF eXpress will be used and the IEEE will have the copyright of the paper. Please read all instructions thoroughly in order to avoid any error that could result in rejection of the document. Particularly, all PDF files submitted to the Web site will automatically be checked for compliance with the PDF requirements and rejected if not compliant (Abstract).

I. INTRODUCTION (HEADING 1)

This template, modified in MS Word 2003 and saved as “Word 97-2003 & 6.0/95 – RTF” for the PC is a customized version of the “MSW_A4_format.doc” IEEE template. A. Equations

Number equations consecutively. Equation numbers, within parentheses, are to position flush right, as in (1).

B. Figures and Tables

1) *Positioning Figures and Tables*: Place figures and tables at the top and bottom of columns. Avoid placing them in the middle of columns. Large figures and tables may span across both columns. Figure captions should be below the figures; table heads should appear above the tables. Insert figures and tables after they are cited in the text. Use the abbreviation “Fig. 1”, even at the beginning of a sentence.
